

Day Lesson Plan for Students 12th Grade On How To Use Google Products

** (10 minutes)**

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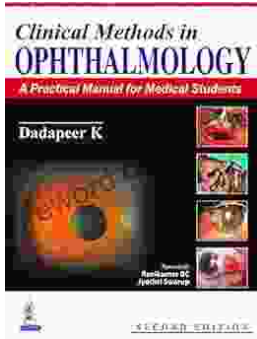
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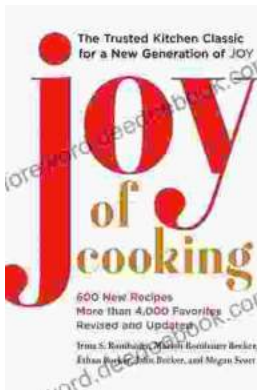
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
