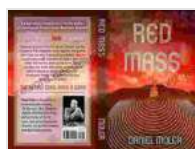


Red Mass 2023: Honoring Archbishop Daniel Moler and the Catholic Legal Tradition

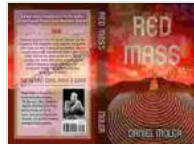
